Mona Zulficar is the Senior Partner with the Shalalany Law Office in Cairo where she oversees the operations of its Banking and Capital Markets Group and chairs the firm's Executive Committee. In addition to her over twenty-five year career as a prominent international corporate attorney, since the 1980's Ms. Zulficar has had a commitment to community activism and has been a strong advocate for human rights and women's rights in Egypt and internationally. She was recently elected member and Vice Chair of the UN Human Rights Council Advisory Committee and is a member of the National Council on Human Rights in Egypt. She has campaigned for a new marriage contract and equal rights to divorce, equal rights under the nationality law, and the family courts campaign. Some of her successful pro-bono human rights cases have included: defense of the Ministry of Health's decree banning female genital cutting, a campaign for a new NGO law, equal opportunity, and a non discrimination law, and a campaign for the establishment of the National Council for Human Rights. She is the author of many articles, and a frequent speaker on women's rights.
